



Spring in Taos, New Mexico

Airports – getting to Taos

The best rates are obtained to fly into Albuquerque, but there is an airport in Santa Fe too and attendees who want a faster transport to Taos have flown there rather than driving the 2.5 to 3 hour drive from Albuquerque.

If flying into Albuquerque, you can get a rental car at the airport. Or you can take the [Sandia Shuttle](#) to Santa Fe and get a rental car. Or you can fly into the Santa Fe airport.

The driving distance and drive time from Santa Fe to Taos is 72 mi / 1:45. Abiquiu is 45 miles north of Santa Fe. The roads from Santa Fe to Taos are a bit windy and can slow down your drive.

Taos Ski Valley, Inc. operates a *year-round* daily shuttle to and from the Albuquerque Sunport. Reservations are required. It is recommended that guests make reservations 48 hrs in advance. Guests need to inform us of # of bags, skis, boards, etc. Limit 2 bags per person, including skis/boards. Child seats are not provided. This is a nonstop *weekend* bus service (Fri, Sat, Sun) between Santa Fe and Taos, sponsored by the Town of Taos. In Santa Fe it connects with the New Mexico Rail Runner train out of Albuquerque and the Santa Fe

Airport (reservations required).

Taos Express fare: \$10 adult round trip/\$5 one way (please have exact fare); children 10 and under ride free with an accompanying adult. Buses are ADA compliant and can accommodate bicycles, skis/snowboards. No charge for up to two pieces of luggage. For reservations and more information call (575) 751-4459.
